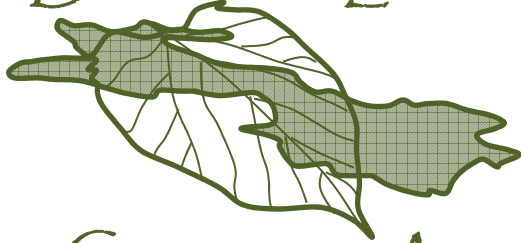

Wildlife and Habitat Inventory

Plans are progressing to involve lake residents in observing and reporting wildlife sightings, plants and their habitats on and around Big Basswood Lake. Observing and monitoring natural phenomena is another way to evaluate the lake's overall health. It also strengthens our connections to and enhances our understanding of Big Basswood Lake and its watershed. These observations will serve as an invaluable benchmark for future reference.

The Central Algoma Freshwater Coalition and the Kensington Conservancy are providing resources to assist in the development of this project.
