# **Chairman's Letter**

Dear Big Basswood Lake Residents,

The winter has come and gone, or was it ever here? Ice was late to form. It left early. It was never solid enough for any winter activity. Is it man made global warming or unusual solar activity? I will not enter that political arena, nor is it the purpose of BBLA to do so. BBLA is here to represent you, the residents of the cleanest lake in Ontario. We can be an intermediary between you and Government agencies, such as Huron Shores, Algoma Health, and the MNR. We are here to protect the health of our lake!

Speaking of Algoma Health, I spoke to Chris Spooney, regional director in Blind River and he stated that very few septic inspections on Big Basswood were completed 2 years ago. Due to staffing limitations, our inspections were not completed. He suggested I call Huron Shores to speak with Deborah Tonelli. She told me nothing is planned at this time. If you, our members, are aware of a septic problem anywhere on the lake, call Algoma Public Health, 705-356-2551, register your complaint, and they will respond. It is possible that Tulloch Engineering may be doing inspections in the future. They will be doing a "test" inspection of Clear Lake, and, if that goes well, they may inspect us in a year or two. Your Board will keep you posted on this issue.

If you have not seen it, look at the lake capacity study for Big Basswood and Bright Lakes: <u>http://huronshores.ca/wp-</u> <u>content/uploads/2011/10/Lake-</u> <u>Capacity-Study-5-Oct-2011-</u> <u>presentation.pdf</u>. Basswood takes almost 25 years to replenish its entire water supply. Amazing!

## News from the WILDLIFE & HABITAT INVENTORY

#### 'Tis the season.....

Last fall the Wildlife & Habitat Inventory went live at

<u>http://www.bigbasswood.ca/forum.php</u> with an on-line forum. So far, just a few of you have signed on. It is a chance for the Big Basswood Lake community to share observations, pictures, ask questions and keep each of us informed about what is happening on and around the lake. Get on-line and sign on now--- *'tis the season* (we all live for). If you are off the grid at the lake, take notes or keep a journal, get on the forum when you get home or get it to me in person, via mail or phone. \*\*\*

Observations from the fall and winter from the Forum:

- Last summer, on the north shore, there was a mama bear with 3 cubs spotted in two different locations.
- Throughout the summer there were many eagle and hawk sightings, including bald eagles & juveniles on the north shore, over Red Rock Lake and even at the dump!
- Pileated woodpeckers.
- A pair of wild turkeys on the south west side of the lake.
- The eastern basin of the lake was NOT frozen on 2-9-12! According to Ice Watchers, the lake froze on 2-10-12 and reopened on 3-18 or 19. This was the shortest winter people can remember.

I encourage everyone to join in with their observations, comments, and pictures.
